CONDITIONS FOR THE IMPORT OF DOGS
Animals (National and International Movement of
Diseases Prevention) Regulations 1994.

This permit is granted subject to the terms and conditions relating to the importation of the abovementioned, set out in the regulation for the time being in force and to the following terms and conditions:

That the animal was accompanied by health certificate signed by a Government Veterinary Officer stating that:

1. The animal was born in and has never left **(COUNTRY)** or where not born in or has left **(COUNTRY)** and returned, has been in **(COUNTRY)** for the previous six (6) months.

2. During the twelve (12) months immediately preceding the exportation of the dog(s) there has been no rabies among unquarantined animals in the country from which the animal(s) is/are exported.

3. (a) The dog(s) was/were implanted with an I.S.O microchip, (as recorded above) followed by a Rabies Vaccination with an inactivated adjuvant vaccine, when the animal was not less than twelve (12) weeks

3. (b) Onbeing at least three (3) weeks following the Rabies vaccination, a blood sample was taken from the said animal following microchip identification, and tested for antibody level at laboratory* (See Annex 1 for list of approved laboratories.

Once the animal has a protective antibody level (>0.5Iu/ml as established by the approved laboratory, the animal can be exported to St. Vincent and the Grenadines), **(Copy of the Laboratory result must accompany this certificate.**

4. The dog(s) is/are in good health and free from symptoms of any prescribed or any other infectious or contagious disease.

5. The dog was screened for heartworm on two (2) occasions within seventy-two (72) hours of export on

6. The animal(s) has/have been treated for external parasites and for internal parasites with an approved broad spectrum anthelmintic.

7. The animals must travel on a direct flight (**IF EXPORTATION IS FROM A RABIES ENDEMIC COUNTRY ONLY) TO ENGLAND** and not be accompanied by any dog or cat except from the same country.

Animal landed in St. Vincent and the Grenadines after 4:00 p.m.. Monday - Friday or weekends / public holidays are subject to inspection fees.

This permit will, unless previously revoked, continue in force until three (3) months after being issued.
